Steve Smith is Senior Policy Advisor to U.S. Senator Angus S. King, Jr. of Maine, and serves as his principal advisor for national security affairs including issues related to the Senate Armed Services Committee, the Cyberspace Solarium Commission, the Congressional-Executive Commission on China, the Senate Arctic Caucus, and the Senate NATO Observer Group. He joined the Senate staff in 2013 after an active duty career in the U.S. Army.

During Steve's Army career, he initially served as an Armor Officer in leadership and staff positions with stateside assignments at Fort Knox, Kentucky; Fort Hood, Texas; Fort Stewart, Georgia and on the Army staff at the Pentagon; with overseas assignments in South Korea, Kuwait, Bosnia, and Iraq. He was later designated a strategic plans and policy officer and served as a strategic advisor in Iraq, military assistant to the Secretary of Defense, and Director for Defense Policy and Strategy on the President's National Security Council Staff.

Steve's education includes a Master in Public Administration from Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government, and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science and History from Wittenberg University.
